







Draw lines as shown.






Draw its ground on which it is lying.

Paper Folding and Pasting

Things you need:


















Take a piece of cardboard to make the base of our castle. Stick a paper glass upside down. Join a cardboard tube on top of it with a masking tape.



Join three other tubes together as shown here. You can use different size of tubes. Use the tubes of used tissue rolls.






Take some pieces of white paper. Roll them to make cones.

These will serve as spires of the castle.

Cut them.



Join four smaller tubes to your model.

5 Stick the spires to your castle.
















Roll some pieces of tissue paper in tube shape.
Bend them to make entrance and windows.
Stick them with the help of masking tape as shown here.

Cover the whole model with White Glue. Now paste tissue paper on it. Let it dry.





You can colour it with colours of your choice. You can use golden glitter glue for spires. You can even add flags on top of the castle.










A Treasure Chest


Paste more ice cream sticks along the wall with the help

Pasting and Colouring














Paste the extra ribbon on the side of the box with the help of glue. Now your cover will open and close.
