

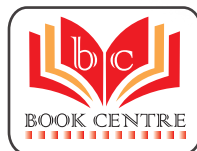

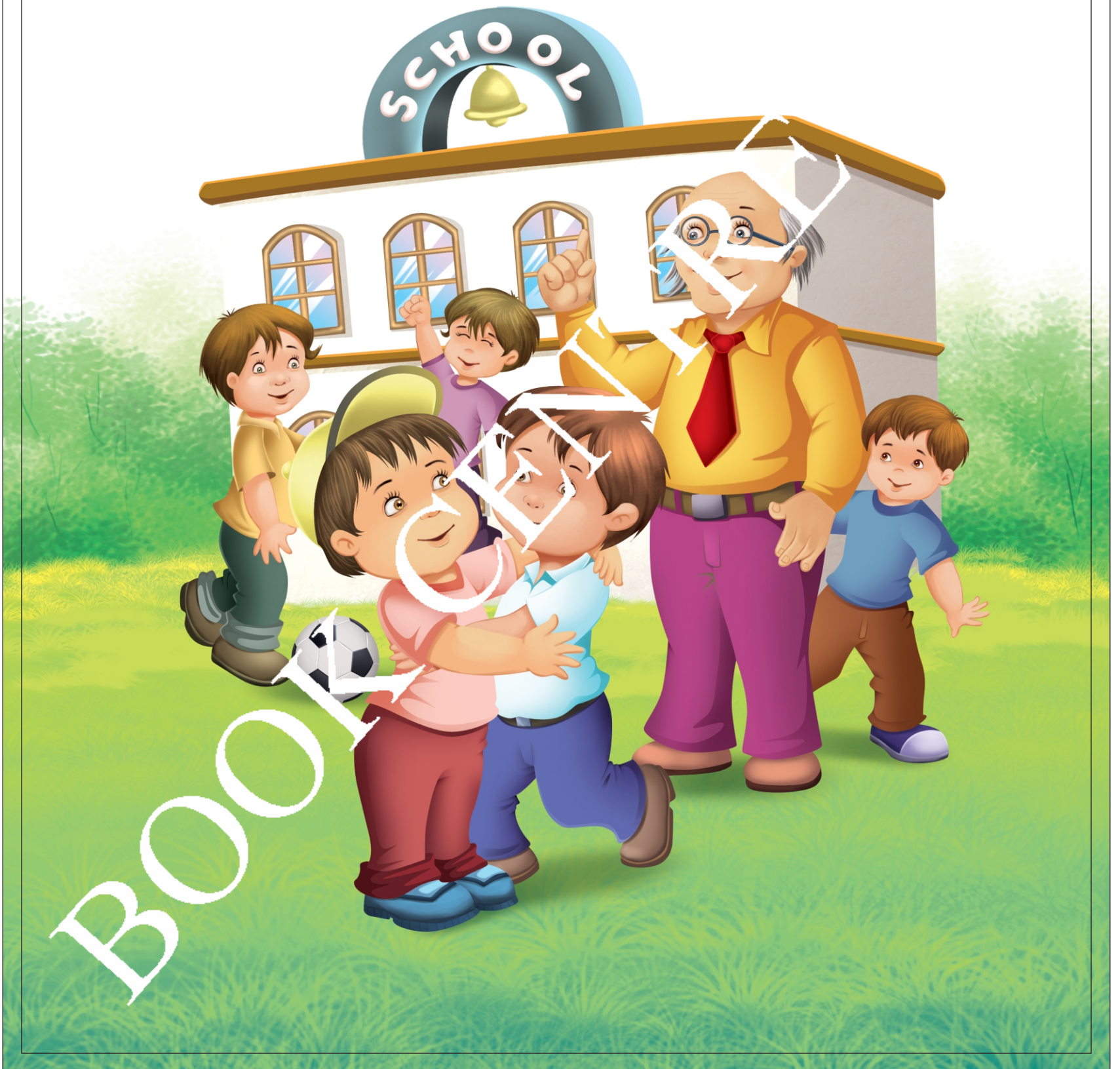
# Anger and Argument

Ali and Bilal were excited as they were going for a picnic with their classmates. They hugged each other when they met and said together, "We will have a lot of fun at the picnic."



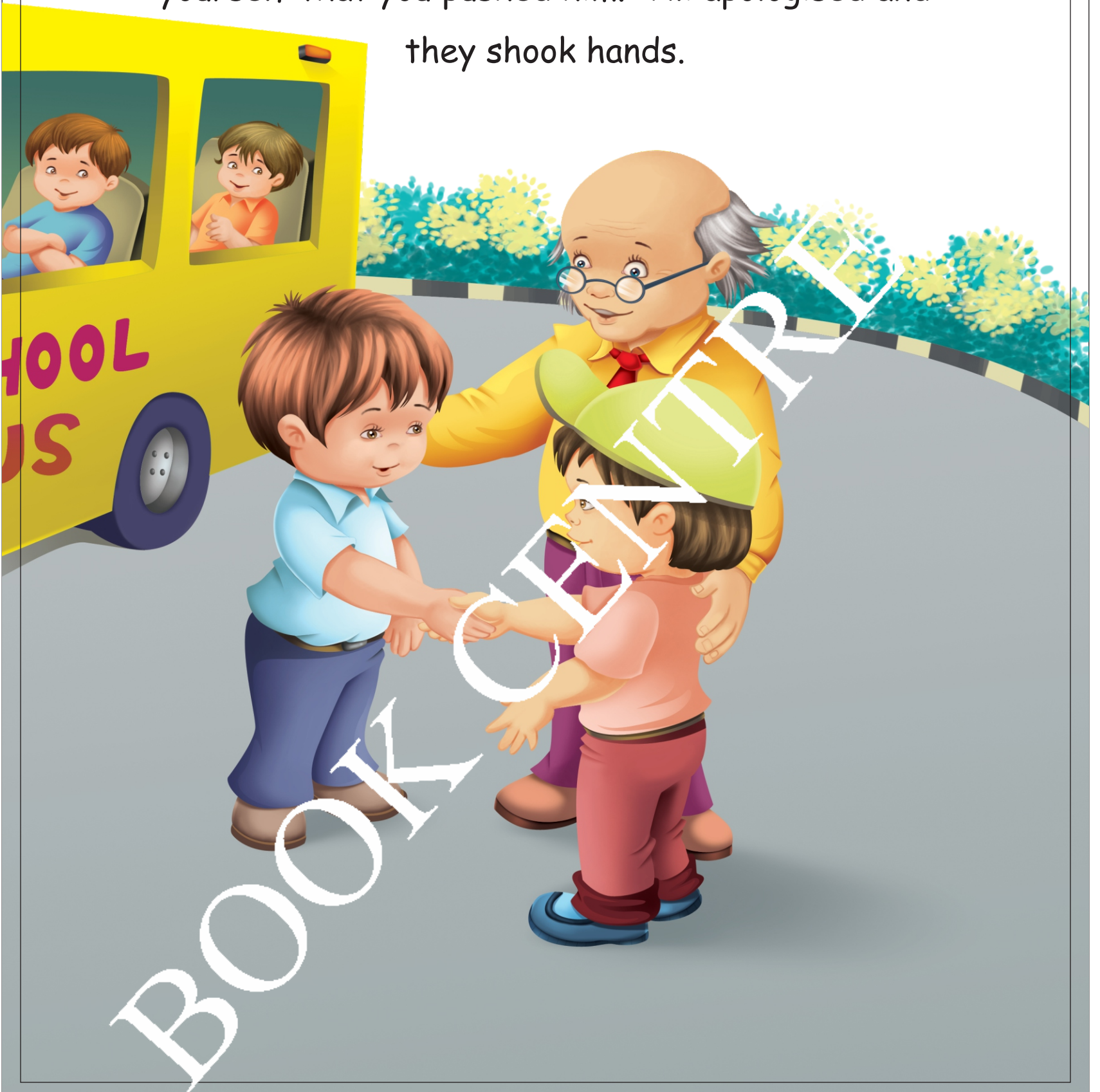
